Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 28 residents and 20 staff members test positive for COVID-19. Denton County Positivity rate has increased to 8%, which requires us to test our employees once per week.

We are now scheduling “Essential Caregivers” for Infection Control Education/Training. Please contact Rachel Shipman or Sandy Urich for further information.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Since the onset of this virus, we have had 28 residents and 19 staff members test positive for COVID-19. We have had 23 residents and 15 staff members recover. It has been 6 days since our last positive COVID-19 case. Denton County Positivity rate has increased to 8%, which requires us to test our employees once per week.
